## Measuring Youth Sexual and Reproductive Health Services

### 01 THE PROBLEM

Adolescents and youth continue to face unique barriers to high-quality sexual and reproductive health (SRH) services that are not well measured.

- Privacy
- Confidentiality
- Provider bias

We convened a globally representative group of young SRH experts and advocates to define the measurement needs in adolescent and youth SRH (AYSRH) service provision.

### 02 THE INNOVATION

A focus on measurement is necessary to identify and provide a foundation for improvement in areas including: unplanned pregnancies, coercive care, stigma, and fear of care providers, all of which can lead to future morbidity and mortality. Services that matter most to youth include:

- Comprehensive sexual education
- Safe abortion/post-abortion care
- Contraceptive services
- Preventative screening
- Gender-based violence counseling
